Great Lakes Theater Romeo and Juliet School Residency Program	Karen A Baker, Jessica Tresko, Jeness Kington, Kate White	AHS	The English department wants to bring Shakespearean actor-teachers to all freshman English classes (4 days, 10 classes a day) to explore and understand Romeo and Juliet from a different point of view. 275 students impacted.	\$3700
Climbing Leighton	Karli Scaffide	Leighton	This grant is for a rock wall installation in Leighton's gym. It would be a permanent structure. The wall can be modified to accommodate all students. Aligns with state standards for PE goals and would be the only one in the district. 700+ students impacted.	\$9301
Leaf Umbrella	Eric Head	AHS Art	This grant is to "buy back" umbrellas designed by art students participating in the Leaf Umbrella project. AHS would display these umbrellas, like a gallery exhibit. The Leaf Umbrella project: https://leaf-ohio.org/singing-in-the-rain-umbrella-auction/ Directly displays the work of 30 students but potentially impacts entire school.	\$750
Virtual reality bringing Immersive learning to our students	Lori Heller (and Gina Voinovich)	Leighton 4 th grade	This grant is for virtual reality headsets for 4 th graders. These are a different brand than the oculus, more of a school-focused company, ClassVR. The original grant was for just one switch team but we are working with the grantee's to roll out eight headsets to share with the entire 4 th grade. Doing a little more research before submitting the PO.	\$4496** (Budgeted for Fall 2023)
Math Games Initiative	Lindsay Julien and Katelynn Serafino	Craddock-Second grade math	This grant is for math games (i.e., Mastermind and Tenzi) for the second grade teachers to use as instructional aids and "learn through play." 225 students impacted. We split with the PTO.	\$463
Literature to Support Social Emotional Learning	Janice Parker Kaitlin Catalani	Leighton	This grant is for social/emotional books. Topics range from controlling feelings to developing friendships. The goal is to build resilience in daily trials. 600 students impacted. We split with the PTO.	\$365
"Mindful Morning Materials"	Dana McNally & Jen Bindus	3 rd grade switch class	This grant is for "mindful morning materials" for a 3 rd grade switch class. These would be used to ease into the day with open-ended, hands on exploration time. (Gear sets, puzzles, magnetic building toys, etc.) 50 students impacted. We partially funded this grant and the PTO funded the balance.	\$500
Sit Pads for Outdoor Learning	Laurie Kidwell and Jen Yonally	Miller	This grant is a seating option for outdoor learning at Miller. Mrs Kidwell and Mrs Yonally take their classes outdoors often. They are willing to store these in a place where the whole school could use them.	\$624
